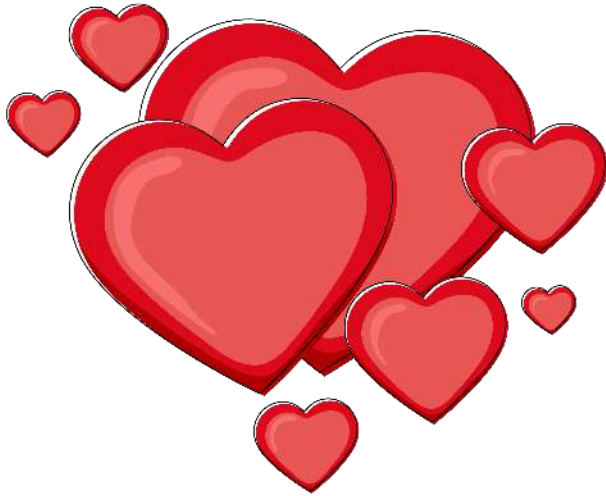

10. Compose a piece conveying the beauty of spending time in nature with a beloved, describing the sights, smells, and sounds they experience together.

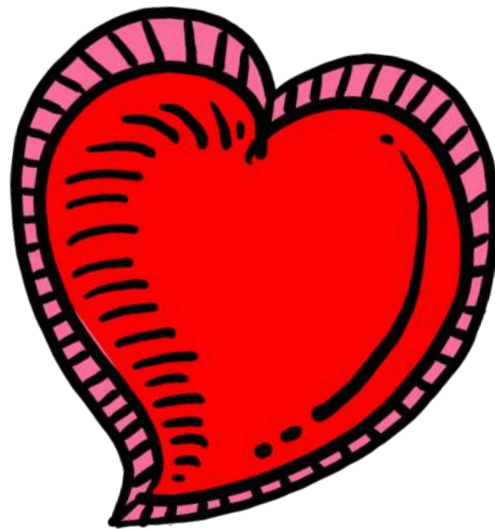
11. Craft a poem that weaves together the many nuances of being in love, incorporating metaphors to capture its intensity and complexity.

15. Draft an elegy for two lovers who could not be together in life but will remain connected forever through their love for each other beyond death itself.



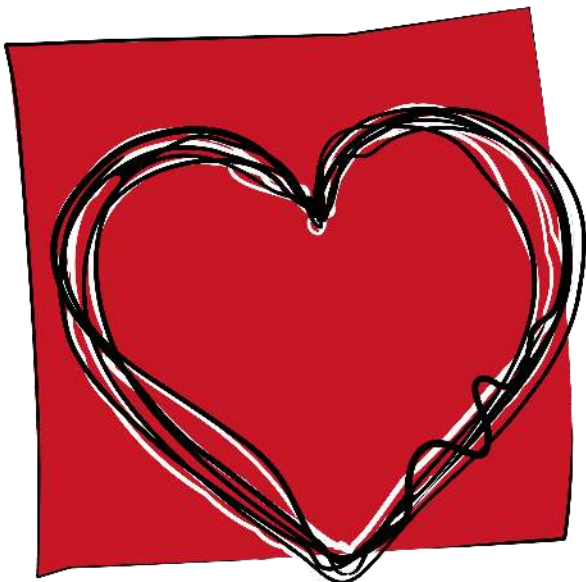
16. Illustrate how passionate affection can be expressed through meaningful gestures rather than words in an engaging poem exploring different modes of communication between couples in love.
